

SECTION 4. WATER AND SEWER POLICIES

SUBDIVISION 1. WATER AND SEWER HOOKUPS. WATER AND SEWER MATERIALS TO INSIDE THE FOUNDATION WILL BE PROVIDED FOR NEW CONSTRUCTION UP TO 75 FEET.

SUBDIVISION 2. WATER RECONNECTION FEE. A RECONNECTION FEE OF \$25 IS REQUIRED FOR ALL WATER SERVICES THAT HAVE BEEN DISCONNECTED FOR 30 DAYS OR MORE. THE WATER SERVICES WILL ONLY BE RECONNECTED DURING BUSINESS HOURS. CUSTOMERS MUST MAKE ARRANGEMENTS TO BE ONSITE AT THE TIME OF RECONNECTION. IN AN EMERGENCY, AFTER HOUR WATER CONNECTION FEE OF \$55 MINIMUM FOR THE 1ST HOUR.

SUBDIVISION 3. WATER DISCONNECTION FEE. A DISCONNECTION FEE OF \$50 IS REQUIRED FOR ALL WATER SERVICES THAT ARE DISCONNECTED AFTER NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS.

SUBDIVISION 4. SUMP PUMPS. VIOLATION OF SUMP PUMP POLICY IS \$50.00 PER MONTH. CANNOT BE CONNECTED TO SEWER FROM APRIL 15TH TO OCTOBER 15TH.

SUBDIVISION 5. TEMPORARY WATER CONNECTIONS. A TEMPORARY WATER CONNECTION FOR RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS WILL BE INSTALLED FOR A MINIMUM CHARGE OF \$55. A TEMPORARY WATER CONNECTION OR FIRE HYDRANT HOOK UP FOR COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS WILL BE INSTALLED FOR A MINIMUM CHARGE OF \$55. INSTALLATION CHARGES MAY INCREASE IF ISSUES ARISE DURING INSTALLATION. A CERTIFICATE OF LIABILITY IS REQUIRED FOR COMMERCIAL INSTALLATIONS. ALL TEMPORARY WATER CONNECTIONS WILL BE CHARGED A MINIMUM OF 2,000 GALLONS MONTHLY.
