

SECTION 3. ELECTRIC POLICIES

SUBDIVISION 1. ELECTRIC SERVICES. THE HALSTAD MUNICIPAL UTILITIES IS RESPONSIBLE TO THE METER FOR AERIAL ELECTRIC SERVICES. THE HOMEOWNER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE UNDERGROUND ELECTRIC SERVICES FROM THE POWER BOX TO THE HOUSE.

SUBDIVISION 2. LEVER BYPASS. ALL NEW AND UPDATED METER SOCKETS SHALL HAVE MEANS OF LEVER BYPASS FOR THE UTILITY TO WORK ON EQUIPMENT WITHOUT BREAKING A LOAD. THE UTILITY WILL SUPPLY UP TO BUT NOT TO EXCEED \$100.00 PER ADDRESS FOR COST OF SUPPLYING A LEVER BYPASS SOCKET. THE CUSTOMER WILL BE REIMBURSED UPON COMPLETION.

SUBDIVISION 3. STOPPED METERS. IN THE EVENT A METER SHOULD STOP FUNCTIONING CORRECTLY THE UTILITIES WILL GO BACK 12 CALENDAR MONTHS AND EITHER REFUND OR COLLECT MONEY OWED.
